ANNOUNCEMENTS

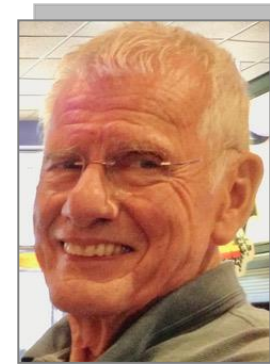
- President- Jon Costolo led the Pledge, the 4-Way Test, and the invocation; Bob Youmans America the Beautiful.
